

Dear Student/Parent,

You are requested to note the following important changes/modifications/additions from CBSE for the present batches of Class IX and X (2018-19).

1. HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION (HPE) for Class IX & X:

The subject HPE is introduced from this academic year 2018-19 in place of present Health and Physical Education (Sub Code- 506) and Work Education (Sub Code-500).

CBSE has mainstreamed Health and Physical Education (HPE) in Schools for Classes IX & X, as a compulsory subject, with the aim of holistic development of the child, leading to a well-balanced individual in all walks of life.

The subject carries maximum 100 marks, only with practical in THREE STRANDS, without theory. Internal Assessment in HPE for every student is mandatory to be eligible to appear for CBSE Board Exams. Marks/ grades of HPE will be submitted online to CBSE. Evidences and Portfolios of student work in the 3 strands will be preserved in the school as they may be monitored by CBSE at any time.

2. Vocational Subject in Class IX 2018-19:

The following additional Subject (6th Subject other than 5 regular subjects – English, 2nd Language, Mathematics, Science and Social Science) for the students of Class IX from this academic year 2018-19 under NSQF (National Skill Qualification Framework).

Name of the Subject: **“Information Technology” (Subject Code-402)**

Total Marks: 100 (Theory-50 + Practical 50)

Theory: a) Part A: Employability Skill : 10 Marks
 b) Vocational Skill : 40 Marks
 c) Practical Lab Activity : 50 Marks

In case, if any student fails in any one of the three elective subjects (i.e, Science, Mathematics and Social Science), pass percentage (33%) in the above additional subject will be considered for promotion to next class. The result of Class IX/X will be computed based on best five subjects including the Vocational Subject. However, if a candidate desires to reappear in the failed subject, he/she may appear along with the compartment examination.

The prescribed material for the above subject shall be made available in June/July. The subject shall be continued in Class X for the year 2019-20 (present Class IX 2018-19).

3. As it is already announced by CBSE, scoring 33% in Internals and in the Annual/Board Examination separately, in each subject is the condition for promotion in Class IX & X from the year 2018-19.
