CLASS X - NTSE 2021

01-11-2021

Students of Class X are eligible for appearing National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) being conducted by NCERT on **January 15, 2022**. Qualified students in the National Level are eligible for scholarship of Rs.1250/- per month for Class XI and XII, Rs.2000/- per month for under graduation and post graduation.

Students who wish to write the examination should collect the Application form from the School General Office to enroll their names and submit the filled in application form along with examination fee of Rs.100/- to be paid in the School Accounts Office on or before 10th November 2021.

Details about caste certificates to be produced is given below.

1. In case of SC, ST, EWS, OBC Non creamy layer candidates Caste certificates issued by the Government of Telangana state only are accepted. Others will be treated as general candidates for NTSE stage - I for the year 2021-22.
2. In case of OBC Non creamy layer candidates common BC certificates like BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E will not be accepted for NTSE stage - I for the year 2021-22 Those candidates who submit the said common BC certificates instead of OBC certificates with non-creamy layer will be treated as general candidates. All OBC creamy layer candidates will be treated as general candidates. OBC certificates of Parents are not accepted.
3. For EWS (Economically weaker section) candidates income & assets certificate issued by Telangana state should be uploaded.
4. Candidates who have not obtained caste certificates by the time of submission of application form of NTSE stage - I for the year 2021-22 should submit a self-Declaration in profarma as stated below and the candidates who submit the said self-Declaration should upload the relevant caste certificates with in the given time. Otherwise they will be treated as general candidates.
