



FIRE SAFETY WEEK CELEBRATION REPORT

Fire Safety Week was observed in our school with great enthusiasm to create awareness among students and staff about fire prevention and emergency response. The theme for this year's celebration was **"Fire Safety in Schools and Hospitals."**

On this occasion, a special demonstration session was conducted by the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF). We were privileged to have the Superintendent, **Mr. Bhandari**, along with his dedicated team, who made the session highly informative and practical.

The CISF team emphasized the importance of fire safety, particularly in places like schools and hospitals, where safeguarding lives is of utmost priority. They explained the common causes of fire accidents and the precautions to be taken in daily life.

A detailed demonstration was conducted on the use of fire extinguishers. Different types of fire extinguishers were displayed, and the team clearly explained their specific uses. The following types were introduced:

- **Water Extinguisher** – used for ordinary fires involving paper, wood, and cloth (Class A fires)
- **Foam Extinguisher** – used for fires involving flammable liquids like petrol and oil (Class B fires)
- **Carbon Dioxide (CO₂) Extinguisher** – suitable for electrical fires and flammable liquids (Class B & C fires)
- **Dry Chemical Powder (DCP) Extinguisher** – effective for multiple types of fires including solids, liquids, and gases (Class A, B & C fires)

The team also explained different types of fires and clearly demonstrated which extinguisher should be used for each type, helping students understand the correct response in emergency situations.

The session was highly interactive, with students actively participating and gaining valuable practical knowledge. It created awareness and instilled confidence among students to act wisely during fire-related emergencies.
